OBJECTION OF DR. MAHAVIR SINGH CHHIKARA

This will decide the objection raised by Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikara for considering his candidature as Invalid on the ground that Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikra was in employment of the Society (SMES) after he became a member of the Society and as such in terms of Rule 4(f) which deals with termination of membership is squarely to him.

The Rule, categorically lays down that the membership will stand terminated the moment a member is employed in the Society and after his gainful employment, he will cease to be a member.

The objection has been raised on the ground that he has been shown as a member in the list displayed on the notice board and as such, is entitled to vote and even to contest the election.

It is to be noted that Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikara, after he became a member of the Society was appointed as a Director (Professor) by the Society and there his name was mentioned as Dr. M.S. Chhikara and not Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikara, though other particulars regarding his parentage and village address remains the same.

Even Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikara has not objected that Dr. M.S. Chhikara and Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikara are one and the same person.

Merely, because due to oversight an illegality is there in the membership list, it will not mean that an illegality is to be continued even after it is noticed, as an illegality cannot persist. Moreover, being a member Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikara was fully aware about the Rules and Regulations of the Society and he himself should not continue as member. That the name of Dr. Mahavir Singh Chhikara because of Rule 4(f) was deleted by the President (SMES) from the list of members displayed on 22.10.2019 and amended list was displayed on 23.10.2019 on the notice board and the website, i.e. before the dates of submission of Nomination Form i.e. 24.10.2019 and 25.10.2019, **the Objection is Dismissed.**

Moreover, under Clause 27 of the Rules and Regulations, it is clearly laid down that if at any time before the commencement of poll, the President of the Society is satisfied that any elector whose name is inscribed on the electoral roll has ceased to be an elector, the President shall have the authority to strike off the name of that elector from that electoral roll.
